Steps to create an account and join the Beacon Team (and support to do so):

- 1. Go to: peoples.ecochallenge.org
 - Choose purple "Join" button top of screen
 - Login with Facebook, Google or create your own account (filling in required fields) then Join!
 - Location and Demographics you can choose in the drop-down menu "Prefer Not To Answer" in the demographics section.
 - Join an Existing Team: type in "Beacon Unitarian" and enter the password 'beacon'; then choose "Join"
 - You can invite friends and family all are welcome (don't have to be part of the Beacon congregation), the more the merrier!
 - Choose "Dashboard" at the top of the website page
