You Belong Here: Putting Beacon on the Map

This church year, Beaconites will be jumping into a new adventure. To build on the work of the Congregational Conversations, we will be learning about who we are and where we live, so that we can make decisions about who we want to be and where we want to focus our energy for the next five years.

All Beaconites who are interested can be involved in "community mapping", a project that involves the whole Beacon community gathering information and learning together about the community where we live. Since Beaconites' community spans a large area, from Burnaby to Maple Ridge and beyond, you will have the opportunity to learn about and teach others about your neighbourhood.

Community mapping helps us to answer questions like:

- 1. Who are we serving?
- 2. Who are we not serving?
- 3. What are gathering places within those areas?
- 4. Who are potential partners for community outreach?
- 5. What are the needs of the communities that fall within Beacon's catchment?

The process is simple and will take us through a variety of stages over the next year. At the end of the year, we should have a deeper understanding of our collective community and can make decisions about how we can use our unique talents and gifts to support our broader community.

On September 24, after the church service, the Family Ministry team will be holding an information meeting to talk about the goals and process of community mapping, and provide details about how each Beaconite who is interested can become involved. Please join us with your questions, your curiosities and your enthusiasm. Come and help put Beacon on the map!
