

Covid Guidelines as of September 8, 2023

MASKS ARE OPTIONAL

Masks are optional, but encouraged, when attending church services and functions.

Please bring a mask from home, to save on mask costs for the church.

We recommend that only those who are fully vaccinated* and have received the 2023/2024 COVID vaccine booster dose (when available) attend in-person Sunday services and other church events.

OUR COVID GUIDELINES:

(as of September 8, 2023)

- **Masks are optional but encouraged at the Sunday services.** Please bring a mask from home to save on costs for the church.
- **If you are sick or experiencing covid-like symptoms** (including fever, cough, shortness of breath or acute fatigue) please join us online from home rather than attending Sunday services in person.
- **Adults who are vaccinated and their children** are welcome to attend in-person Sunday Services and other church events. (Sunday services and many other church events are available online for participation from home).
- **If you are not vaccinated**, please attend remotely via our Zoom link for Sunday services and the applicable Zoom links for other church activities and meetings.
- **Doors will be open for ventilation** as much as possible. (If it's chilly outside, keep your coat handy!)
- **Please use hand sanitizer upon entering Sapperton on Sundays.**
- **Non-Sunday events or meetings** may be held online or in person dependent on the group's decision. They will decide their masking policy. If you are sick or experiencing covid-like symptoms, please stay home from in person events until those symptoms subside.

*fully vaccinated: those who have received the full primary series of COVID vaccine(s) (i.e. those first dose(s) available in 2022)
