## Inca Medicine Wheel Rose Matovich

Rose Matovich has been a member of Beacon for over 30 years.

She trained in the Inca Medicine Wheel practice through the "Four Winds Society" led and founded by Alberto Villodo. During the course of her training, she travelled to Peru and was initiated into two of the nine Munay Ki rites by the shamans in the high Andes near Cusco in Peru. When you accept the Munay Ki rites you accept stewardship of the earth and become an earth keeper.

In this service Rose will open space according to the tradition of the Inca Shamans. In the opening words and the lighting of the candles she will call on the winds of the archetypes and the four directions. She will share some of the core teachings she learned in her training and explain the concepts.
